Current Step: \Wiring Eliminator 0001\Preliminary power on procedure\Ground check

- 1.) Connect the black cable from your multimeter to the input ground (center pin). This value MUST be smaller than 0,5 OHM. Record your measurement below.
- 2.) Now measure with the red probe on the filter cover case. This value MUST be smaller than 0,5 OHM. Record your measurement below.
- 3.) Second measurement is to the ground of power supply number 9 (Green wire with yellow stripe). This value MUST be smaller than 0,5 OHM. Record your measurement below.
- 4.) Third measurement is to the Neutral pin (silver prong with L shape) on the Main Input Power Socket. This MUST be "open" with the multimeter on the 20Mohm range. Record your actual reading below.

Training Portal

ProWorks includes a Training Portal that Managers and Trainers can use to keep track of individual employee's training schedules and certifications. Training your workforce on actual productions jobs, takes the guesswork out of whether the individual was paying attention during the training process.
